KIS Facilitated Dialogues

Overview

The KIS Facilitated Dialogues will be an informal online webinar discussion amongst various jurisdictions and Dr Rick Fiene, the creator of the Key Indicator, Risk Assessment and Differential Monitoring methodologies. A Book of Readings and Slides will be provided to each participant as we move through the topics to be discussed. Rick will provide suggestions to get us started but this discussion/dialogue will go where the participants are interested in going.

March 2018 Discussion: Program Compliance and Program Quality

Rick will lead a discussion on the relationship between program compliance and program quality borrowing from the work of Gwen Morgan who was one of the leading pioneers in the field of human service licensing and helped to establish much of the infra-structure for the field.

July 2018 Discussion: Risk Assessment and Key Indicators along with Instrument Based Program Monitoring (tentative, unless the group discussion takes us into a different topic)

This discussion will focus on Instrument Based Program Monitoring (IPM) and abbreviated tools based upon the Risk Assessment and Key Indicator methodologies. We will look at the continuum from comprehensive tools to abbreviated and targeted tools.
